

## (ANNEX TO THE APPLICATION GUIDELINES)

### JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2024 (THAILAND) — SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS —

Additional to the Application Guidelines, the details of the selection and some special requirements are set by the Embassy of Japan in Thailand as following. **Please read carefully before submitting the application.**

#### 1. QUALIFICATION

- (1) Applicants must have Thai nationality.
- (2) Applicants must have attained a **cumulative GPA of at least 3.00** on a 4.00 GPA scale at an upper secondary school.

#### 2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of screening the submitted application documents, written examination and interview. The decision on successful candidates made by the Embassy of Japan is final and the reasons will not be disclosed. Any queries on the final decision will not be entertained.

Please understand that submitted application documents will be screened. Applicants may be narrowed to take the written examination. MEXT scholarship selection for 2024 in Thailand may be cancelled in case a written examination cannot be conducted due to the COVID-19 situation.

##### (1) APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

The following documents **must be sent by post** as hard copy documents **and must arrive** at the Bureau of International Cooperation, Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education **no later than Wednesday, 31 May 2023**. Late application will not be accepted.

6	Certificate(s) of graduation of school/university attended	1 copy	Only for those who graduated. <b>The copy must be attested by an authorized official of the school/university, not a photocopy.</b>
7	Certificate of university enrollment	1 original	Only for those who currently enrolled in a university.
8	Certificate of English or Japanese language proficiency <u>with score</u>	1 copy	If applicable. (JLPT, TOEFL, IELTS etc.)

**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. **These documents must be written in English or Japanese**, or translation in either of these languages should be attached.
2. The Embassy of Japan does **not request to submit Recommendation Letter and Medical Certificate at the time of application**. They will be requested when applicants have passed the First Screening. Please submit the application documents following the above list.
3. Your application may be rejected if the above application is incomplete, or if some documents are missing.
4. The submitted documents will not be returned.
5. The set of application documents **must be sent only by post** to the following address. Hand or Messenger Delivered documents will not be accepted.

**(2) WRITTEN EXAMINATION**

Date: Sunday, 25 June 2023

Place: Applicants must choose **one** of the following examination venues and **circle on the Admission Form**.

- 1) Bangkok
- 2) Chiang Mai
- 3) Khon Kaen
- 4) Songkhla

\*Any of the examination venue is subject to cancellation depending on the COVID-19 situation.

- (3) RESULT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION** will be announced on the website of the Bureau of International Cooperation (<http://www.bic.moe.go.th>) on Wednesday, 12 July 2023.

Only successful candidates will be called for an interview.

#### (4) INTERVIEW

The interview will be given in English and/or in Japanese for those who have knowledge of Japanese language.

(5) **RESULT OF INTERVIEW** will be announced on the website of the Embassy of Japan in Thailand on Friday, 21 July 2023.

### 3. RECOMMENDATION TO MEXT

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will recommend **candidates who have passed the First Screening** to MEXT. MEXT will then conduct the Second Screening of the recommended candidates and decide the scholarship grantees.

Therefore, those who pass the First Screening will not necessarily be selected as the MEXT Scholarship grantees.
