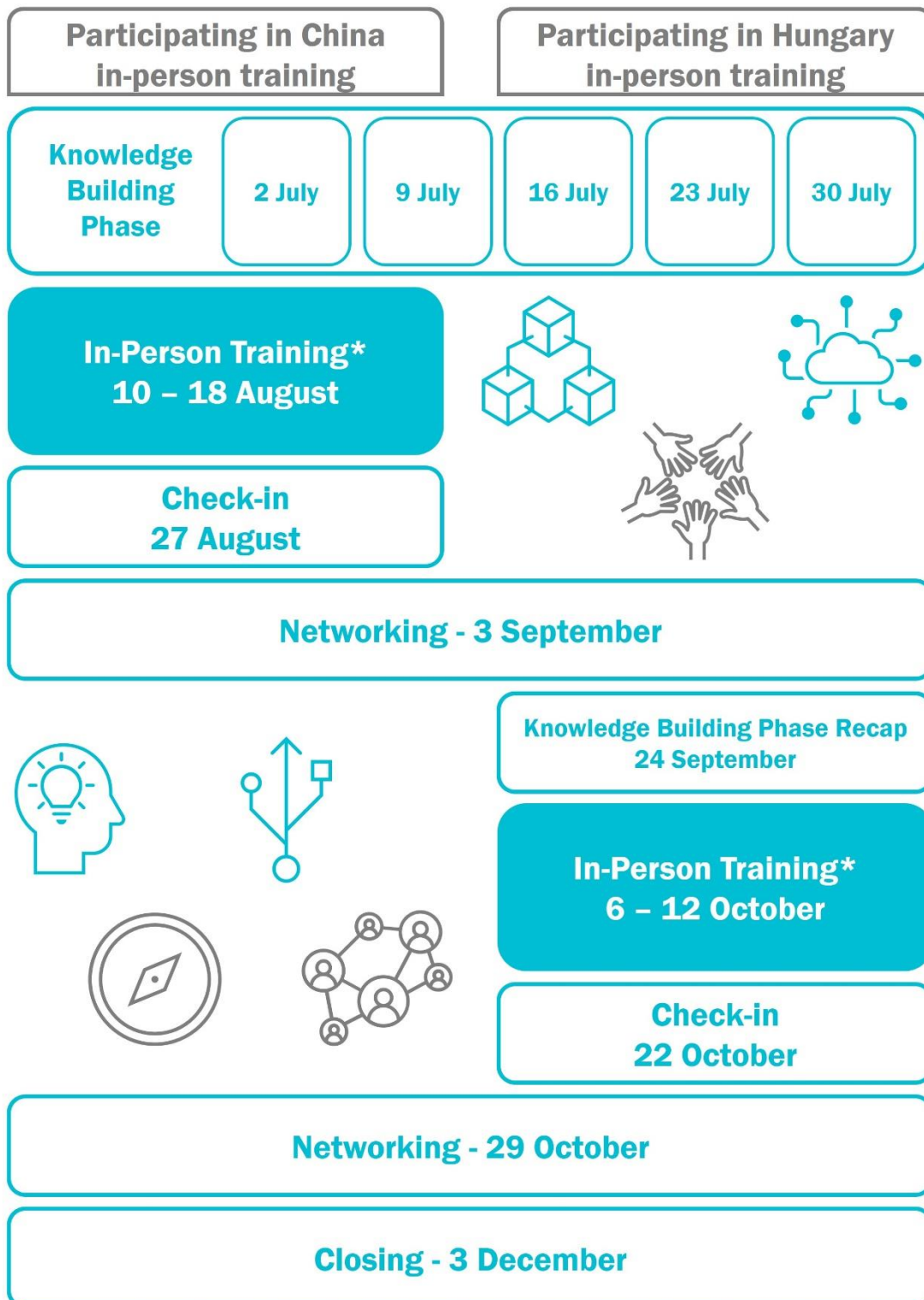


## Programme Snapshot
